PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The Chair recognizes Senator Wehrbein on the advancement of LB 514A.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. President, and members, I understand the A bill, Senator Bromm. I was just...I do notice they ask for two more FTE, is that two more people in that agency?

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: I believe that's correct, Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: No big issue, just want to call attention. I am going to do this more and more, but I just wanted to recognize cash funds, something we need to do. I am supporting the bill. This, what, eventually adds to our space requirements in the state of Nebraska, in the terms of office space. Just the little things, nothing reflecting on the bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Seeing no further lights, Senator Bromm, you're recognized to close on the appropriations bill to LB 514. Senator Bromm waives closing. Those in favor of the advancement of LB 514A to E & R Initial vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 514A is advanced. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. The Appropriations Committee gives notice of agency hearings. And notice of hearing by the Health and Human Services Committee. Committee on Business and Labor reports (LB) 331 to General File, (LB) 95 is indefinitely postponed, (LB) 257 indefinitely postponed, (LB) 342 indefinitely postponed, (LB) 619 indefinitely postponed.
