CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 163A.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 163A is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, Retirement Systems reports (LB) 703 to General File. Government reports (LB) 60 to General File, (LB) 117 indefinitely postponed, (LB) 118 and (LB) 380...or (LB) 117 and (LB) 118 indefinitely postponed. Health reports (LB) 380 to General File with amendments, likewise with (LB) 411, (LB) 440, (LB) 519, (LB) 308 indefinitely postponed. Senator Byars has amendments to (LB) 194 to be printed.

New A bill. (Read LB 148A by title for the first time.) There will be an Executive Session of the Transportation Committee tomorrow morning at 8:30 in Room 2022. That's all that I had, Mr. President. (See pages 535-541 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Speaker Kristensen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. Members, tomorrow, just to give you a heads up where we'll end with the week, we're going to do some Final Reading tomorrow morning. There's probably a dozen bills or so. Then we're going to go back and pick up General File, we left off this morning, and I move that we adjourn until February 12th at 9:00 a.m.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. The motion before us is adjournment. Those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. We are adjourned.
