CLERK: (Read LB 47 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 551 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 47 is passed. Mr. Clerk, LB 57.

CLERK: Senator Chambers would move to return the bill.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers on his motion to return to Select File LB 57.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the discussion that I had thought about having on this bill I will save for another day, so at this time, I will withdraw that motion. But, before I do, I want to ask Senator Brashear a question, if he's here.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, Mr. President.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Brashear, I think the new plates that they have for everybody are abominable. That's...
