action, would adopt...the Environmental Quality Council adopt regulations regarding corrective actions necessary to protect human health and environment at hazardous waste treatment, storage, or disposal facilities. The regulations could require the owner or operator to undertake corrective actions for releases regardless of when the waste was placed in the unit. The second section of the act would authorize the Director of the Department of Environment Quality to issue an administrative order requiring corrective action necessary to protect human health and the environment for a release from the facility.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Amendment on the desk.

CLERK: Senator Schrock would move to amend the bill, Mr. President. (See FA21 on page 579 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Schrock, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR SCHROCK: We have a little amendment here that changes the word "of" to "or". It's page 12, line 18. It's corrective action that needs to take place.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Discussion on the Schrock amendment. Seeing none, Senator Schrock, you're recognized to close on your amendment. He waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Schrock amendment to LB 784. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Schrock's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The Schrock amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: We'll move to debate on the advancement of the bill. Senator Schrock, seeing no debate, you're recognized to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 784 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay.
