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brought up some good points there. Maybe the public should decide or help decide who's going to take these over if the president resigns or some other means leaves office. This is why probably he should be on the ballot at the same time or...so people know who's going to be his running mate. So maybe he'll announce early. Who knows, it might inspire another vote. But I do like Senator Chambers' idea there. But the objective here is to have a team work together. So many times they don't work together. The Lieutenant Governor doesn't do a whole lot, and I hate to say that, but many times it's that way, not necessarily now, but many times it's that's way. I guess we've been lucky in the last few years here. But I'm support this and I think it will be better for the people, it'd be better for...better for (inaudible) government as a whole. So I'm...I'm all supporting of this CA. Thank you.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you. Mr. President, members of the body, this...this particular idea of Senator Chambers I believe has some validity, and I'm having legal counsel look right now because I don't believe it says anywhere in our constitution right now that the Governor or the Lieutenant Governor has to be of the same political party. I think that's in statute and that's probably the proper place for it to be because I don't believe we even...I don't think we even mention political parties in the constitution itself. I'm still exploring that and I know that Senator Chambers is going to have an amendment up there to remove that provision. I told him I don't know what effect that will have, what kind of fallout that will have on members of the body and whether they can support this or not, but my idea and the idea I have in my head is that next year we will come back and have legislation introduced which will put...which will lay out the parameters of this process of selecting a Lieutenant Governor, including, I would argue strongly, that they should be of the same political party. But for a constitutional amendment, Senator Chambers is probably right, we probably shouldn't have that in the amendment itself. If we pass that legislation last...next year then, we...and I would guarantee that an early hearing, we could do that in advance of the constitutional amendment actually being placed on the ballot, either in the May primary or the November general
