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SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator Bohlke, you are recognized to open on the committee amendments. (AM0282 is found on page 523 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR BOHLKE: The committee amendment recognizes the same problem with the Mid-Plains Community College, as I indicated, and does the same as far as correcting the boundaries until we do the new census.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Any discussion on the committee amendments? Senator Vrtiska.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Senator Wickersham, members of the body, ask a question of Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator Bohlke, will you yield?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Well, I've been looking at the map. I can't see where the difference is. The amendment does the same for both colleges, I understand, but where...what's the difference in the map?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Senator Vrtiska, it's really the voting precincts that...that are different. If you'll look, that you see how Lackey and a number of those of voting precincts change from the old to the new. These are the voting precincts, apparently. In the old map, you see the ones outlined in black and in the new map you see that those are not.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay. I was looking at the line that went down through it and I couldn't see any difference. I see what you're talking about. I...I'm glad (laugh) I'm glad I asked the question because I was confused, which is not unusual, but then it's...

SENATOR BOHLKE: I may have confused you, Senator Vrtiska. I don't know if I said boundaries and...

SENATOR VRTISKA: I understand now.
