SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...have to pay a fee.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's what I wasn't clear on. Thank you.
That's all that I have.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate on the Wehrbein amendment.
Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Only to say I'm sorry about the confusion.
The E clause is the only difference between the two amendments.
I...we forgot to file the E clause on the first bill (sic) and
so the second amendment, and the second amendment had the
E clause and that's the reason for my neglect in mentioning
that. The only difference between the two amendments is the
E clause, which this one has. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question
before the body is the adoption of the Wehrbein amendment to
LB 359. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote
nay. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator
Wehrbein's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The Wehrbein amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I move we advance LB 359 to E & R
for engrossing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The motion before the body is the
advancement of LB 359. All those in favor say aye. Those
opposed say nay. It is advanced. LB 359A.

CLERK: I have no amendments to 359A, Mr. President.
