CLERK: (Read LB 66 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 735 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 66 is adopted. LB 66A.

CLERK: (Read LB 66A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 735-736 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present not voting, 2 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 66A is adopted. LB 77.

CLERK: (Read LB 77 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 736 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 77 is adopted. Mr. Clerk, LB 168. On LB 168, we have a motion to dispense with Final Reading. Need 30 votes in the affirmative to do so. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record.
