PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Is there discussion on the advancement of LB 90A. Seeing none, Senator Bromm, would you like to close? Senator Bromm waives closing. The question before us is the advancement of LB 90A. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 90A.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 90A is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 407A.

CLERK: (LB) 407A, Mr. President, by Senator Crosby. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. To open on LB 407A, Senator Crosby.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. President and members, 407A follows LB 407, that's logical, I guess, and you remember that LB 407 sets up a ten member commission to study the child support guidelines adopted by the Supreme Court. This commission would report to the Supreme Court and the Legislature annually on its findings. The commission is under the auspices of the Legislative Counsel. So this travel is for the commissioners when they come into the meetings, and there would be some contractual services, and you'll notice there is federal money and there is some General Fund; 6,630 and 4,420 of General Funds in the biennium, and 12,870 and 8,580 of federal funds, a total of 19,500 in '99-2000, and 13,000 in 2000-2001. I will answer questions if you have them and I'd appreciate your vote to move the bill so it catches up with the bill, itself.
