SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. Yes, I have no objection to the amendment. Thank you, Senator Beutler. It just wasn't thought of when the bill was drafted, so I support the amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Bromm. There are no other lights on. Did you wish...closing is waived. The question before the body is the Beutler amendment to LB 101. Those in favor please vote aye; those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR BEUTLER: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Smith, for a motion.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I would move we advance LB 101 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR COORDSEN: You've heard the motion. All of those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill, LB 100, no Enrollment and Review amendments. I do have other amendments. The first, Senator Beutler, I have AM0356 in front of me on this bill, Senator.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I'd withdraw that, Mr. Clerk, as well as the following two.

SENATOR COORDSEN: They are withdrawn. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator, I missed part of what you said. I've got
