Senator Pederson for his patience in working all these things out and I think these amendments help a great deal. Thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Beutler. There are no other lights on. Did you wish to say anything in closing on your amendment? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Pederson amendment to LB 100. Those in favor please vote aye; those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Pederson's amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Smith, for a motion.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I would move we adopt LB 100 or advance LB 100 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR COORDSEN: You heard the motion. All in favor of advancing LB 100 to E & R for engrossing say aye. Opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 14, no Enrollment and Review amendments. Senator Schimek would move to indefinitely postpone the resolution. Senator Schrock, as the introducer, you'd have the chance to lay the bill over, Senator, or resolution, I should say.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: I do not want to lay the bill over.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Would you turn the mike on, please.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mister...
