PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bohlke, do you have...rise?

SENATOR BOHLKE: We said it was advanced to E & R Initial? Is that correct?

CLERK: Senator, it was advanced to E & R for engrossment. That's what the...

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I would move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 141.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Motion before us is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 141. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Wickersham, AM0667. (See page 857 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Wickersham, you're recognized to open on your amendment to LB 141?

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Mr. President. For all purposes, this is a technical amendment. We are removing sections from 141 that were addressed in LB 194 and, to reduce confusion in the Revisor's Offices, it's advisable that we remove Sections 2, 3, 10, and 12 in the bill and amendments thereto and make the other changes that you can see in the amendment. I can't tell you that this amendment has any substance at all except for the issue of reducing confusion in the Revisor's Office, if this bill should pass, and any conflicts with (LB) 194. Thank you.
