PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 927 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 39 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 8 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 682 is passed. Pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8, the question is, shall LB 784 be considered for a vote without an at-large reading? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 34 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to dispense with reading, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is agreed to. Mr. Clerk, please read the title.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read title of LB 784.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay.
