The resolution will be laid over, but pursuant to its introduction I have a communication from the Speaker and a subsequent Reference report referring LR 43 to the Agriculture Committee for public hearing.

Mr. President, Enrollment and Review reports LB 498, (LB) 574, (LB) 386, (LB) 386A to Select File. Retirement Systems reports (LB) 246 and (LB) 874 indefinitely postponed. Natural Resources reports (LB) 701 to General File with amendments, (LB) 748 indefinitely postponed, (LB) 749 indefinitely postponed. Government reports (LB) 204 to General File, (LB) 729 to General File with amendments.
