SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. The motion is ad...the bill is advanced. Anything for the record, Mr. Clerk? Senator Bohlke, you are recognized to open on the A bill. (LB 314A)

SENATOR BOHLKE: Thank you, Mr. President. The A bill, I think we've had quite a bit of discussion on. And, as I've said, it is the money that was not appropriated from the Mitigation Fund, last year, but would appear then as a fiscal impact this year, for 2.7. Thank you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Is that your closing also, Senator Bohlke? You've heard the motion. We'll now vote on the advancement of LB 314A. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes, Mr. President. Looks like we're going to have to have a call of the house, but I'll accept call-in votes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Shall the house go...the question is, shall the house go under call? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: The house is under call. Will all members return to the Chamber. The house is under call. All members return to the Chamber. Call-in votes are authorized.
