Schumacher of the Crete Carrier Corporation. He was vice president in charge of insurance, and he thought that a January 1, 2000 effective date would be appropriate to make sure that they have their internal processes aligned. I asked the Court of Compensation and they had no difficulty with that date and, given the good faith of the parties that sat down and worked the bill out, I would like to respond in kind and offer this...this somewhat later date for the implementation of the act to allow parties to basically accommodate the procedure and get their facts, figures and internal processes in order. For that purpose, I ask for the adoption of a January 1, 2000 effective date for LB 331.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Landis. Discussion? Senator Landis, you're recognized to close. Senator Landis waives closing. The question before us is the adoption of Amendment 833 to LB 331. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Landis's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I would move the advancement of LB 331 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question before us is the advancement of LB 331. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, (LB) 612.

CLERK: Mr. President, Legislative Bill 612 on Select File, has been discussed on Select File. First motion I have this morning is by Senator Bromm. Senator Bromm would move to bracket the bill until January 10, 2000.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bromm, you're recognized to open on your motion to bracket.
