PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Good morning everyone, welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the forty-ninth day of the Ninety-Sixth Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain for the day is from Senator Chris Beutler's district, Pastor Dr. Mike Loudon, from the Eastridge Presbyterian Church. Doctor.
