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they don't have the expertise. They wouldn't begin to know...they wouldn't know how to begin doing this. So this is not one of those where all the people in the small communities are against it. There are police agencies who wanted it in its unamended version, where it said the State Patrol would do the investigating, because they just didn't want to have to do it because they couldn't. They didn't have the expertise or the person power. So, my answer to your question precisely is that I believe the state should require the appointment of a special prosecutor in these instances, and the county should pay the cost of the special prosecutor.

SENATOR ENGEL: And I agree with everything, except the cost. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Engel. SENATOR BROMM: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, Senator Chambers, I have a couple of questions, and I've asked a number of questions about the language, but this goes more to the passage of the bill. And let me say that I think that a lot of the substance of your bill is very, very worthy. And I think I'll be able to support a lot of it. I have some...I do have some concerns about some of the language. And in that respect, as you know and I know, when we bring a bill back from Final Reading, and I may be saying this more for the benefit of those who haven't been here quite as long, we can only adopt the specific amendment that you're proposing. We have.... Is that correct? Senator Chambers,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That...that's correct.
