PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. The question before us is the amendment, 852, to LB 72E. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK:            39 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Select File amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted. Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President. I would move the advancement of LB 72E to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion before us is the advancement of LB 72 to to E & R for engrossment. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The ayes have it. The bill is advanced to E & R for engrossing. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I do have items, if I may. I have a Reference Report referring certain gubernatorial conferees to Standing Committee for public hearing. Confirmation report from Natural Resources. LB 51, (LB) 211, (LB) 324, (LB) 346, (LB) 632 reported correctly engrossed. (LB) 603 is reported indefinitely postponed by Natural Resources. Education reports (LB) 812 to General File with amendments. Bills read on Final Reading this morning were presented to the Governor. (Re: LB 87, LB 60, LB 100, LB 101, LB 214, LB 380, LB 411, LB 440, LB 440A, LB 479, LB 703, LB 703A, LB 802, LB 375, LB 17, LB 234, and the constitutional amendment, LR 14), was presented to the Secretary of State.
