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what...and listening to the discussion. But I do think, because I see that there's a 12 to 14 million dollar, I'll call it, windfall, may not be quite an accurate term for cities and counties, that there ought to be room somewhere in there for a reallocation of some of that money. I'm not clear of where. I'm not clear yet as to what that formula should be to make it happen, especially in light of the fact that if we do something with Douglas County, which there is that amendment up there, if that's there that changes the complexion of the issue. So, to me, I'm not...I'm really not sure at this point where it should be...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...but I do know I need more information and I'm sure the Appropriations Committee will feel that they will need more information before they would make a decision this afternoon or even in a couple weeks, especially if we tinker with the formulas for cities and/or counties, or counties and/or cities if we tinker with those formulas. And that's why I would urge you to look at these numbers, at least. There's nothing about formula on these books, but at least it gives you the numbers in what we've been doing. And I think we do need more information, which we will have to have and probably not today. Overruling the Chair, if that's the best way to get at it, I would overrule the Chair. Otherwise, I prefer a rule suspension, which I think Senator Beutler's going to offer. I think that may be the more appropriate way to get at this issue. Either way, I feel it has to be discussed.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Mr. Speaker, I obviously rise to support the ruling of the Chair. For those who believe that the issue needs to be discussed, we can perhaps do that if, as Senator Wehrbein suggested, Senator Beutler brings a motion to suspend the rules and you really do want to talk about this. And I'm not going to suggest that it isn't something that you do need to talk about, but you need to talk about it in context. Senator Beutler is suggesting to you this morning that this is something that has to be done for the NRDs this year. Well, we've handed around a sheet, and it's our...the Revenue Committee staff's and
