PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. Pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8, the question is, shall LB 632 be considered for a vote without an at large reading? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 1 nay to dispense with Final Reading, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is agreed to. Mr. Clerk, please read the title.

CLERK: (Read title of LB 632.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1206-1207.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
