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match and the harm that can be caused when the match is ignited, under the wrong circumstances, or in the wrong place. So when you give the power to make laws to people who are so easily dominated and intimidated or "purchased", and I put the word purchased in quotation marks because I use it advisedly, we wind up with idiotic proposals of the kind we have here. One of the staunchest gun nuts in the state of Nebraska, probably in the universe, nay, in the Milky Way, would be none other than "Baron" Tyson, and he doesn't think this is a good bill, he knows it's not a good bill. There is no gun he wants that he cannot get right now without this bill. And if he wanted to go about armed, he probably would. But there are people, both he and I, feel are unfit, not only to be denied a license to carry one of these guns hidden in the clothing, but to even own a gun or possess one. And some of them testified before the Judiciary Committee. When you have a chance to be in the presence of...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...these people, then you see how serious this matter is. After a few hours, my colleagues begin to get tired, they get saturated, and they lose touch with how serious this matter is. But there are some of those mad people out there, just waiting, breathing hard, getting moist palms, cannot wait for the chance to run right down and do whatever is required to do to get a permit that says they can hide all the guns in their clothes they want to and go out on the streets. And, contrary to what Senator Janssen tried to tell us this morning, I don't believe there is anything in this bill that limits a person to one concealed weapon carried at a time. So I'm going to be here, continuing to discuss this matter. And if you all don't get cloture, woe upon you, and woe to the Legislature...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...as far as the rest of the session.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. There are no other lights on. Senator Kiel, you're recognized to close on your amendment.
