SENATOR KIEL: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature. Again, what this is intended to do, because we have not really been able to make a determination as to whether or not the fee for concealed weapons permits is going to pay for itself or pay for the cost of administering this program and doing everything that's required, what this simply does is, it is the intent of the Legislature that this ought to be revenue neutral. No application of carried concealed handgun shall be accepted and no license issued at any time when the Concealed Handgun License Fund does not have sufficient funds to pay all the costs of processing an application for such license. It's very simple. It keeps the state off the hook for any General Funds appropriations. It simply says this is a program that's got to pay for itself. And I would also ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote, please.
