CLERK: Just one. I have amendments to be printed to LB 543. That's all that I had, Mr. President, thank you. (See page 1266 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: Only one time a day, Mr. President. No corrections at this time.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will next proceed back to LB 704. Chair has had an opportunity to review the request for division, made by Senator Chambers. We had the first component, which was Section 1. The remaining amendment is divisible. Those divisions will be as follows: the second component shall be Section 33; the third component will be pursuant to a document that's being passed out to the membership right now that has several sections, beginning with Section 2; then a fourth division, fourth component, dealing with Sections 3, 4, 8, 9, 28, and 30; and then the remaining provisions will be in the last component, all pursuant to the document that has been handed out. Senator Bromm, it's my understanding that you want to take these in the order that they have been listed in the sheet. That would be Section 33 would be the second component.

SENATOR BROMM: That's correct, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You're recognized to open on that component. (See FA77 on pages 1266-1268 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you. As the Speaker has indicated, the Pages are passing out a division of the committee amendments, which breaks down into four parts. And we'll deal with them, 2, 3, 4, 5, as they are listed on that sheet. The first component being Section 33 on page 29 of the committee amendment. Last...last year, in LB 1056, we passed a provision which we thought was all required by federal law, but after session learned that in fact a certain portion of it was not. And this would...would repeal that portion that was not required by federal law. What this would do would be repeal the requirement that farm trucks be labeled with a federal DOT number. That was
