SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: This morning our chaplain for the day is Pastor Steve Wing from the Hickman Presbyterian Church, which is in Senator Byars' district. Pastor.

PASTOR STEVE WING: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Pastor. I call the fifty-seventh day of the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature to order. Senators, please record your presence. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: I have one item, lobby report for this past week to be inserted in the Legislative Journal. That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. Mr. Clerk. We're going to move to consent calendar this morning. I just to remind the members of the ground rules for consent. If there are any three members who object to a bill being placed on consent calendar, they have to give me, in writing, a letter. I'm going to extend that here for a couple more minutes, but once we get past the first bill or two, we will not do that. If the debate extends beyond 15 minutes and the introducer is not closing, the bill will be removed. And if any amendment is adopted other than the Standing Committee amendment which has new subject matter, I will remove that from the consent calendar. We have one bill, LB 656, which will not be taken up today. It's at the bottom of the first page; 656 will not be on consent calendar this morning. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 319, Mr. President, offered by Senator Brashear. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 12, referred to the Judiciary Committee, advanced to General File. There are
