SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate on the committee amendments? Senator Vrtiska, you're recognized to close on the committee amendments. He waives the closing. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendments are adopted. Debate on advancement of the bill? Senator Landis, you're recognized to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 753 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of a motion to advance LB 753.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 753 advances. LB 131.

CLERK: Mr. President, (LB) 131 was a bill introduced by Senator Tyson. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 7 of this year, referred to the Judiciary Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I have no committee amendments. I do have an amendment from Senator Tyson.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Tyson, you're recognized to open on 131.

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. LB 131 makes two changes to 28-1229. Mr. Speaker, there is an amendment, and I ask that the amendment be withdrawn.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: It's withdrawn.

SENATOR TYSON: LB 131 adds to the definition of what constitutes a destructive device, that is to say a bomb, by including those elements for bottle bombs, expanding gas bombs.
