SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: (LB) 581 advances. LB 799.

CLERK: (LB) 799, by Senator Jensen. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 20, referred to Health and Human Services, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Jensen, you're recognized to open on 799.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. LB 799 relates to the practice of pharmacy and a category of people known as supportive pharmacy personnel. The bill simply repeals two sections of statute relating to supportive pharmacy personnel, deletes references to those sections and declares an emergency. The first repealed section, Section 71-1,147.37, contains a termination date for all provisions related to the use of supportive pharmacy personnel. These references are now retained with the repeal of the termination date. The second repeal section requires a study on the utilization of supportive pharmacy personnel and that study has now been completed. I urge the advancement of this bill. Thank you, Mr. President.
