CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Messages, reports, and announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, a series of appointment letters from the Governor requiring confirmation hearing. Those will be referred to Reference for referral to the appropriate Standing Committee for confirmation hearing. That's all that I have, Mr. President. SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Smith, on the resolution.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. President, members. Just wanted to open on this LR 60, it is on behalf of the National Collegiate Athletic Association that recognizes April 6, 1999, today, is Student Athlete Day in Nebraska. And I think it's important to emphasize that academics and athletics, when in balance, create a stronger individual and role models for the youth of our society.
