SENATOR SCHIMEK: Call of the house, if we're not already still under call. Call of the house, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for the call of the house. All in favor of call the house vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unexcused personnel please report to the Chamber. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Price, Senator Redfield, please record your presence. Mr. Clerk, read the roll, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1324.) 23 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 480.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 480 does not advance to E & R Initial. I raise the call. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 550, LB 822 to Select File, some of those with E & R amendments. Mr. President, Senator Engel would like to print amendments to LB 594. Series of hearing notices from Transportation Committee, and a new resolution, LR 61, by Senator Coordsen. That will be laid over. That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President. (See pages 1324-1329 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Mr. Clerk, next item. Senator Redfield, you are recognized for a motion.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Senator Cudaback, I move that we adjourn until 1:30 this afternoon...or recess until 1:30 this afternoon.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a motion to recess until 1:30 this afternoon. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. I think the ayes have it. We are recessed until 1:30.
