Finally decided that we didn't want to leave any vulnerability for the schools, that we would reinsert that language and let the...our department fight with the United States Department of Education and that...maybe that issue may come back next year, but that's why. That was the area that we've really been having the most discussion on, and the other was just presented to us by the department as...certainly not as broadening or doing any of the issues that we don't want to do, but certainly...but was presented to us as areas that they thought that their wording needed to be improved. And so, with that, I would ask for the adoption. Thank you.
