**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING**

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning our chaplain for the day is Pastor Nancy Gillette from the Florence Presbyterian Church in Omaha, which is Senator Lynch's District. Pastor.

**PASTOR GILLETTE:** (Prayer offered.)

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** I call the sixty-second day of the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature to order. Senators, please record your presence. Roll call. (Visitors introduced.) Please record.

**CLERK:** I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any corrections?

**CLERK:** (Corrections read, Legislative Journal page 1405.) That's all that I have this morning.

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** Messages, reports, or announcements.

**CLERK:** Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 778, LB 640, LB 806, LB 755, LB 499, LB 722, LB 759, LB 734, and LB 585 to Select File, some of which have Enrollment and Review amendments attached, and that's all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 1405-1407 of the Legislative Journal.)

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We next move to resolutions, LR 63.

**CLERK:** LR 63, Mr. President, offered by Senator Baker, found on page 1379, asks the Legislature to extend its sympathy to the family of former Senator Rex Haberman.

**SPEAKER KRISTENSEN:** Senator Baker, you're recognized to open.

**SENATOR BAKER:** Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. As you well know, Senator Rex Haberman died April 1st of 1999 in his home there at Imperial. He suffered from emphysema and congenital heart failure which most of us are aware of that, but he did serve in the Legislature for four full terms from '79 to
