perspicacious ruling, spot on, and that is, when there are two speakers that speak against and there's multiple lights, I don't think there's been enough debate. I support the Chair in its decision that insufficient debate has been had. I have introduced this idea. I've had it fall into the Bermuda Triangle of the General Affairs only to be pulled out by 25 votes. I've then had the Chair come back and say, give me back the bill and let me work it out. I said, okay. When I agreed to that, it went into the Bermuda Triangle of the General Affairs Committee and it came out with provisions that were so offensive this full body stripped them. Then it went back into the Bermuda Triangle of the General Affairs Committee, and it would not see the light of day until agreement was made with the enemies who have fought this for three years. That's enough. I play fair, but this is long enough. And if I have to make the point today, it's sitting here with 25 votes, as this bill does, and being denied a forum, which it's going to be denied today, is exactly what I've suffered for three years, of having 25 votes and being denied an opportunity to have that vote come to the floor and have this body wreak its will in this area. This is simply that which goes around comes around, and today is "comes around." It is not the beginning, it is a...it is a step way down the path from where we began, and I believe...I think that the time is up and I'm going to relinquish my time. If not, I'll go on with the issues of the day.
