CLERK: Mr. President, hearing notice from Education Committee. Enrollment and Review reports LB 76 to Select File. Senator Bruning, an amendment to LB 76. And LR 72, by Senator Byars. That will be laid over. (Legislative Journal pages 1604-1610.)

Mr. President, next bill, LB 835A. I have no amendments pending to LB 835A, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 835A to E & R for engrossing.
