PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Seeing no other lights, Senator Peterson, you're recognized to close. Senator Peterson waives closing. The question before us is the adoption of AM1254 to LB 704. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Peterson's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Next amendment, Mr. President, is offered by Senator Bromm. (AM1292, Legislative Journal page 1496.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bromm, you're recognized on AM1292.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor. This amendment really comes about, when the E & R amendments were prepared to 704, it was determined that there were some...some items that were a little...that needed to be harmonized and done that were a little more significant than E & R amendments could do. So I consider this a follow-up to the E & R amendments. I don't consider there to be, again, policy questions in this amendment. It is...it is very much language harmonizing and technical, and I'm going to try to get the points for you. And if you look at the amendment, there aren't a lot of additional words. There's just some crossing out, but let me try to tell you what it does. This amendment standardizes the appeals when your license is revoked or cancelled for nonresidents to the appeal procedure set out in our present statutes of 60-4,105, and it provides that nonresidents can appeal this cancellation to the district court of Lancaster County. It again adds some language that provides that you can apply for your driver's license in any county rather than just your county of residence. It adds some needed language to clarify the transition period between the current system of requiring that your license must be obtained in your county of residence and the system we are trying to move to which allows you to acquire that license in
