SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Raikes. Mr. Speaker, you wish to be recognized?

New resolution LR 75 by Senator Price, in Executive Board, will be referred to the Board as it calls for an interim study. LR 76 by Senator Lynch. (Read LR 76 by title for the first time.) That will be laid over. I have an Attorney General's Opinion to Senator Quandahl (Re: LB 331). And finally, Madam President, a series of reports that have been filed by with the Clerk, will be so noted in the Journal and available for member review. That's all that I have at this time.
