SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. The house is under call. Would all senators please check in. Would all unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Would all senators please take your seats and record your presence. Senator Stuhr, Senator Bromm. Senator Schrock. Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Madam Chair, could we...I'd like to request a reverse order vote, please.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Coordsen had already requested a roll call vote in regular order. All present and accounted for. We are voting on the Redfield amendment to LB 630. A request has been made for a roll call vote in regular order. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1705-1706.) 15 ayes, 15 nays on the amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment fails. I'll raise the call. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Wehrbein. (FA122, Legislative Journal page 1706.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Wehrbein, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Madam President, members of the body, this is the amendment that Senator Wickersham had on his amendment that does allow for not only share rent but cash rent equivalent so that it does provide that...very similar to his, that this...where my bill says cash rent...or, share rent this also said it can be a cash rent equivalent, so that it can be either share rent, cash rent or a combination, much like Senator Wickersham had in his amendment that he introduced.
