SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have is by Senator Chambers. (FA125, Legislative Journal page 1736.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Microphone malfunction)

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further pending to the budget bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Seeing no further lights, Senator Wehrbein, did you wish to close on LB 880?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Nothing more to say, Mr. President. Thank you. If there's, as I said earlier, if there's questions, you may ask the committee, ask the Fiscal Analyst any questions you may have on the budget between now and Select File. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Seeing no further lights, the question before the body is, shall LB 880 be advanced to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on advancement of LB 880 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted? Have you all voted that wish to? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of LB 880, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 880 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Very quickly, Senator Dwite Pedersen, an amendment to LB 663. Enrollment and Review reports LB 299, LB 539, LB 630 as correctly engrossed. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1736-1737.)
