SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments are adopted to LB 879. We are now debating advancement of LB 879 to E & R Initial. We are now open for discussion. Senator Wehrbein, did you...?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: The committee amendment has become the bill, Mr. Speaker. I don't have anything...I do not have anything to add.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. We are now voting to advance LB 879 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 879.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 879 is advanced to E & R Initial. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: LB 873 by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced January 27, referred to Appropriations, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President. (AM1227, Legislative Journal page 1624.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wehrbein to open on LB 873.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Mr. Speaker and members, this is a bill that's fairly complicated, and if you want to get into it intensely, I'd encourage you to look at your fiscal note, either on your machine or in your books, because that is exactly the way the bill is. It's fund transfers and fund transfers and fund transfers within DAS. It is no additional General Fund money. It...except that it takes some money from the Vacant Building and Excess Land Fund and transfers it to various funds so that we can pay for a new roof on the State...Omaha State Office Building, a new roof on the Lincoln State Office Building, and the Governor's security around the mansion. And if you want to look at that or if you are looking at it, it's a fairly complicated process. It's a fiscal note on LB 873. It's not in your book. It would be in your bill file or on your machine under 873 fiscal note. And there's several transfers in
