LB 878, 879

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1839-1840 of the Legislative Journal.) 32 ayes, 11 nays on the amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to. The call is raised.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Discussion on advancement of LB 878. Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I think I have nothing, Mr. President, and members, I have nothing more to add I believe to this construction bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. The question is the advancement of LB 878 to E & R for engrossment. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Aren't we on Select File?

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: I apologize. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced. We are all allowed one little mess up now and then, aren't we? Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 879, Senator Smith. E & R amendments, first of all. (AM7135. See page 1793 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 879.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 879. Those in favor say aye; those opposed nay. The amendments are agreed to.

CLERK: Senator Wehrbein would move to amend with AM1599. (See page 1813 of the Legislative Journal.)
