PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes. Mr. President, members, this is the deficit bill, for those of you that want know it. This is strictly a technical amendment that we have offered. It...involves Health and Human Services and the Nebraska Educational TV Commission. Both agency, the issue is the same. It eliminates the reappropriation language in the deficit bill. Reappropriation language is and should be included in the main capital construction bill, or the operating budget bill. There should not be reappropriation language in the deficit bill. Obviously, it should be in the other two. This corrects that previous error. I urge adoption.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Discussion on Amendment 1599? Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to close. Senator Wehrbein waives closing. The question is the adoption of Amendment 1599 to LB 879. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Voting on the Wehrbein amendment. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wehrbein would now offer AM1615. (See pages 1840-1841 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to open on Amendment 1615.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Just...I've got to find that one. Oh, that's right. I have it right here. This has to do...another technical amendment, Mr. Speaker, members...has to do with Program 12, which is State Treasurer's salary. We had to recalculate a program, and it was \$302.96 short. This corrects that in the deficit bill for the State Treasurer; \$302.96 correction.
