SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 873 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is the advancement of LB 873. Those in favor say aye; those opposed nay. (LB) 873 is advanced.

CLERK: LB 876, Senator. I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.
