PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 860.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 860. Those in favor say aye; those opposed nay. The amendments are agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to LB 860, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 860.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is the advancement of LB 860 to E & R. Those in favor say aye; those opposed nay. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: LB 663, Mr. President. Senator Wehrbein would move to amend with AM1571. (See page 1803 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to open on Amendment 1571.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, Mr. President, members. This is a technical amendment. It changes the fund source of the State Building Fund and identifies a specific budget number, or a program. The State Building Fund is merely the proper designation for General Funds used for capital construction. It also adds a program number for the \$2,500 that was included in Dwite Pedersen's amendment. That should be Program 648, which is the historical markers program of the Historical Society, if you recall. So they're both technical corrections.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Discussion on the Wehrbein amendment? Senator Wehrbein waives closing. The question is the adoption of Amendment 1571 to LB 663. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Voting on the Wehrbein amendment. Please record.
