much one year, but you've got to return exactly the same amount the following year. It provides a system for calculating those amounts, less the collection fee, and calls for the treasurer to certify that amount to the entity that overcollected. This does not solve a problem that occasionally occurs with undercollection. Senator Jones has experienced that in his district. This is an overcollection issue, and it would be due to an error in a levy.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein (sic). Discussion on the Wicker...excuse me. Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Discussion on the Wickersham amendment? Senator Wickersham, you're recognized to close. He waives closing. The question is the adoption of Amendment 1272 to LB 36. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Voting on the Wickersham amendment. Please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wickersham's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Quandahl has AM1595, but I have a note he wishes to withdraw it, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Quandahl.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Yeah, but we're going to withdraw that one. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is withdrawn.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Actually, this one is not withdrawn. (AM1639. See page 1842 of the Legislative Journal.) There is one that I filed after this that I do intend to withdraw later on, and perhaps ask that this be returned or taken off Final so that we can refile it. But anyway, speaking to the amendment...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Quandahl, would just...hold up here just a moment here...

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Yes.
