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the same regulations as much as possible.

SENATOR C. PETERSON: Okay. And that was the purpose of this amendment that we just passed, which was drafted this morning?

SENATOR SMITH: I believe it was.

SENATOR C. PETERSON: Okay. Was there a public hearing held on any of this, or was there discussion of any type before this was done?

SENATOR SMITH: I'm not on the Natural Resources Committee, and I...you know, there's probably been some legislation in the past, but...

SENATOR C. PETERSON: Um-huh.

SENATOR SMITH: ...as far as this certain situation, not to my knowledge.

SENATOR C. PETERSON: Um-huh. And I certainly understand the concerns you have about the level playing field and the terminology. I just think that what we've done at...in...in somewhat of a swift motion here, without input, certainly I know I, as a senator, would liked to have had input because I have a variety of constituents that own lots, myself included, that have these little areas. And so I'm reluctant to go ahead and change the terminology without actually knowing the impact it's going to have. And while I understand your concern about doing that, I would be more comfortable, and maybe the body would not agree, to pull it out at this time, take some time to work at coming up with a response before Select File, but reconsidering the motion now, working together for something for Select File, and going on that way.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith.

SENATOR C. PETERSON: Yes.

SENATOR SMITH: I would entertain that, sure.
