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are accurate and reasonable. So I would encourage the body to support this amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Further discussion, Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Chambers, I am just curious. I wasn't listening awhile ago when you were speaking, Senator Chambers. I wasn't listening awhile ago when you were speaking, but I understand that you said young Senator Quandahl and Senator Schimek. Was the "young" a qualifier for both of us, I want to know?

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If I were going to refer to you, Senator Schimek, I'd say the young and beautiful Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Oh, thank you. (Laugh) I wasn't fishing for that, but anyway, thank you, Senator Chambers. Ladies and gentlemen, I'm kind of in a difficult position here between a rock and a hard place because the committee advanced the bill and, as Chair of the committee, I am supposed to, I suppose, represent the bill here on the floor, but it's very difficult because this is a half a million dollar price tag and I think it jeopardizes the whole bill, frankly. If this does advance to Final Reading and it goes over to the Governor's Office, I can imagine that it could go right down the tubes. I don't know. I'm not sure that I think that the language in the Robak amendment does provide for the Secretary of State to figure these costs. I think if we're going to do it we ought to be more specific about what we're actually paying for, and I don't think we really know here exactly what we're paying for, so it's possible that it could be taken up again on Select File, Senator Robak, with maybe a little bit more work or whatever. I guess I'm thinking that, for right now and this time and place, we ought to let it go and not adopt this amendment and address some of the questions that had been raised before we actually adopt the amendment.
