CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Raikes' amendment.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The Raikes amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Smith for a motion.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 240 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The motion is to advance LB 240 to E & R for engrossing. All those in favor, please say aye. Opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 119A, Senator Crosby would move to return the bill for specific amendment. The amendment is AM1701. (Legislative Journal page 1950.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: (Gavel.) Senator Crosby to open on your amendment, please.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. My machine isn't working. I can't bring the amendment up. I know it has a change of the program. The only reason we're changing...Mr. Clerk, it...

CLERK: I'm sorry, Senator?

SENATOR CROSBY: Would you tell me the name of the program? I'm sorry. The number. The number.

CLERK: It's Program 340, we're striking 349 and inserting 348, Senator.

SENATOR CROSBY: Right. Right. That's all I need to know.
