Thank you. My machine right now, I can't bring...oh, Liz is here. Three...it's just to change the number of the program. It's a technical amendment to just change the number of the program. That's all it does to the 349? To...it changes it from Program 349 to 348. I'm sorry I wasn't ready to tell you what it is. But it's simple, and believe me, it doesn't do anything except change the number of the program. Thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Crosby. Discussion on the Crosby amendment? Seeing none, Senator Crosby, did you wish to say anything more? Is closing waived? Closing is waived. The question before the body is the adoption of the Crosby amendment to LB 1119A (sic 119A). Those in favor, please vote aye, those opposed nay. We're voting on the Crosby amendment. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The motion is adopted. Anything further on the bill? Senator Crosby, did you wish to say anything in the introduction of your amendment?

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you very much, Mr. President. No. I just would say again, all this amendment does is change the number of the program from 349 to 348. And Senator Hartnett's computer is working, and that's where I'm getting my information. So thank you.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Crosby. There are no other lights on. I assume closing...closing is waived.

SENATOR CROSBY: I waive closing.

SENATOR COORDSEN: The question before the body is the adoption of the Crosby amendment to LB 1119A (sic 119A). Those in favor, please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
