LB 331, 538, 550

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Smith, you're recognized for a motion to advance LB 538.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 538 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the motion. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 538 to E & R for engrossing. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. It is advanced. Members, would you please return to your seats for Final Reading? Members, before we begin Final Reading, I wanted to give you a little information about next week. I...there will be meals provided Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. I would expect that we probably would go longer on Tuesday and Thursday than we would on Wednesday, so that may not be as long, but there will be meals provided. That's a full week next week. Then the week after that is our last week. I would expect Monday and Tuesday, and depending how we work on the 89th day, if the work load is such that we can work through the noon hour on Wednesday, the 89th day, and be done, I would not make lunch plans for that Thursday. But again, it depends on what the work load does, and if there's a tremendous amount that needs to be done that day, we would have a recess during the noon hour on that Wednesday. Mr. Clerk, LB 331.

CLERK: (Read LB 331 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 331 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 2138.)
39 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, 9 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 331 passes. LB 550. The first vote is to dispense with the at large reading of LB 550e. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed nay. Record.
