SENATOR SCHIMEK: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 355 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: All in favor say aye, all opposed nay. Thank you. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, did you have any items?

CLERK: No, not at this time, Madam President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: So we will move to LB 870, LB 870.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 870, E & R amendments first of all, Senator Smith. (AM7140, Legislative Journal page 2176.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Madam President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 870.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: All in favor vote aye, all opposed vote nay. Thank you. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Dierks would move to amend with AM1730. (Legislative Journal page 2059.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Dierks, would you like to open on your amendment?

SENATOR DIERKS: Yes, Madam President, thank you for the opportunity. This is an amendment that was brought to us somewhat hastily. The animal industry is going through some changes right now that the...and the changes are that the rendering plants across the state are having difficulty keeping their profitability and so they have started to charge in some instances picking up dead animals.
