SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to LB 870. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted who care to? We're voting on the Beutler amendment to LB 870. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR BRUNING: Mr. President, I move LB 870 to E & R for engrossing.
